

LEARN HOW TO CARVE AN ICE SCULPTURE!

Christmas in Ice is holding the **4th Annual Wells Fargo Junior Ice Carving Competition in December 2017**. Last year the event was well received and we had incredible sculptures from the young adults. We feel very strongly that training young adults to enjoy ice carving is essential to the continuation of this art form. We are proud to offer this opportunity to keep ice carving alive. The competition was made possible in part by a grant from Wells Fargo, for which we are very grateful.

The competition will be held on December 16, 2017. Christmas in Ice will be presenting this opportunity to young adults ages 14-18. The carvers will be given one 4'x6'x14" block of ice to carve the design their own design. The junior carver will be paired with an experienced ice carving mentor. The mentor will supply the tools and give tips to the students throughout the day. The application must include a sketch of your proposed ice carving and a liability waiver form signed by you and your parent or guardian.

Safety training and general instruction on how to use the specialized hand tools will begin at 8 am on that day. The carving competition will start at 9 am. Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided to the students and the mentors. The carving competition will end at 6 pm. One half hour will be given for clean-up of tools and setting two lights, which will be provided by Christmas in Ice. Judging will begin at 6:30 pm and all carvers must be off the ice.

The winning student will receive a \$500 cash. Second place will get a \$250 cash. To make the event even more fun, there will be a People's Choice competition. Come cheer on the artists and vote for your favorite.

The mentors will receive a \$200 stipend and the mentor of the winning carver will have special bragging rights when you become a star.

The applications are due by December 4 and we will call you by December 8 to verify your acceptance. There are a limited number of spaces available based on how many mentors we have. Applications with a sketch and signed liability form can be dropped off at North Pole City Hall or Design Alaska, 601 College Road in Fairbanks.
